The Run

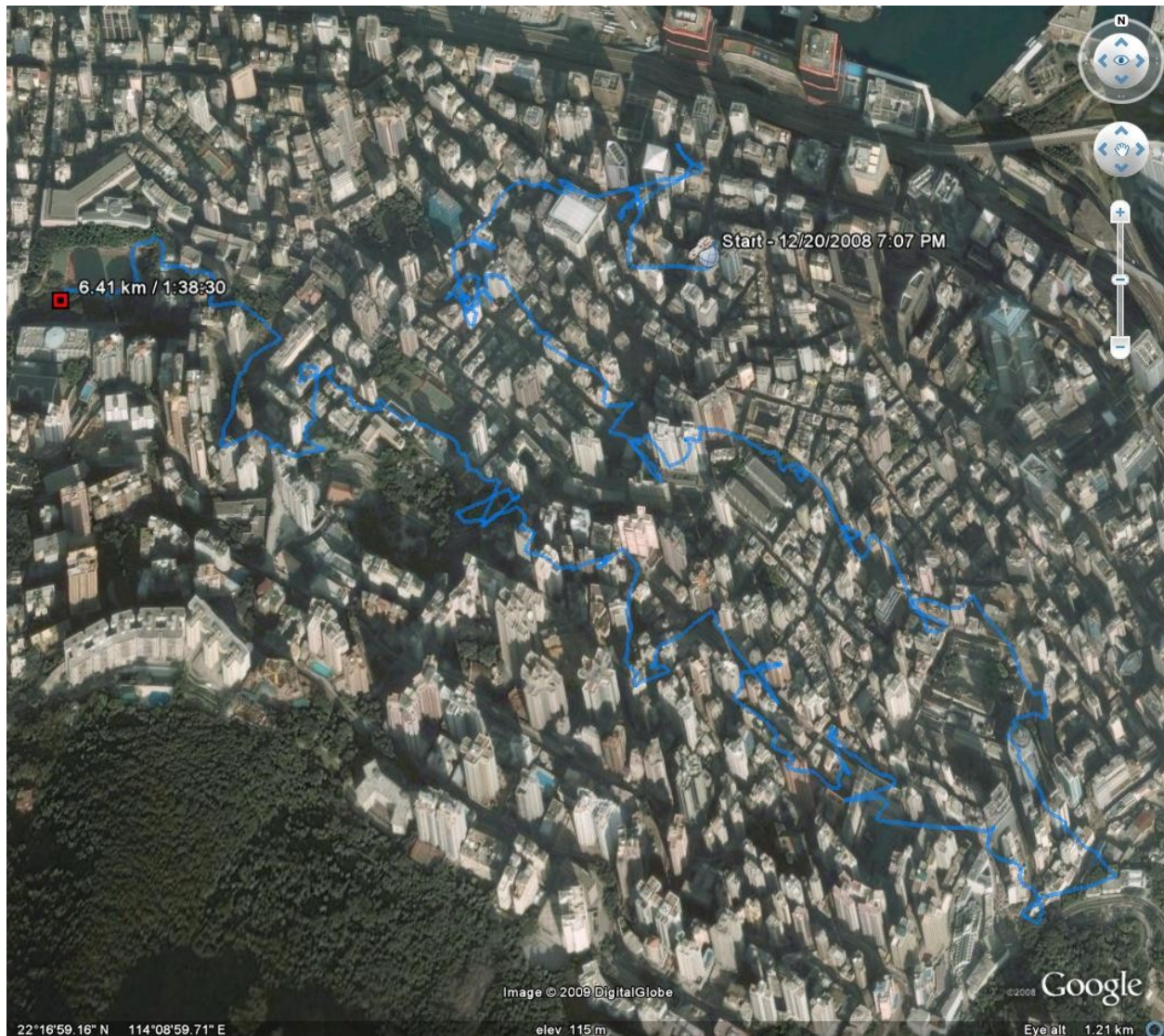
