Marafart & ET - gossiping on trail and letting the girls solve the checks

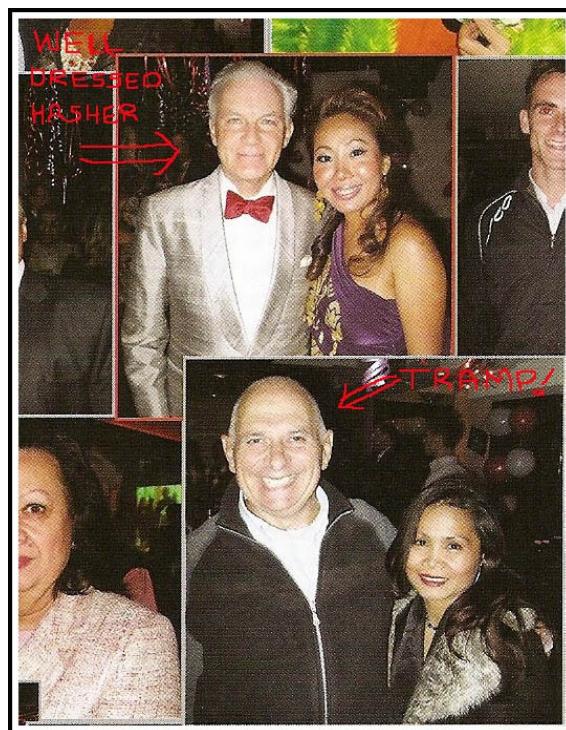
## Hopeless Circle
