Warm up

Contrary to the run notes, we didn't assemble at Parkview, but down at the foot of the hill at Wong Nei Chung in the oft used sitting out area underneath Park Place. Those hashers refusing to slum it on Citybus found themselves ejected from taxis at the wimp/Rambo split, rather than A and it required Hopeless to head off up the hill to mark the way back down before we could assemble a pack of roughly 30 for a prompt (??!!) 4.15 start.

Woody set us off telling us to expect an easy, flat run with no shiggy "if you use your imagination".

The run

After making a conscious effort not to start the pack at the BBQ pits at the top of the hill, the trail immediately took us straight up the road, with the pack being lead by Hopeless (ascending a second time), Bware Wabbit and a fit-no-name-newcomer. We reach the barbeque pits and the split with the Rambo trail continuing on the Tai Tam Reservoir road and the Wimps heading left into the Park.

Rawhide called in to stand in for husband Haggis, who's too scared to come to the hash in case Virgin Mary beats him up about the state of the embroidery on the fleeces.

GM calls in Woody, Dribble, Bware Wabbit, Smallbone, Pink Pofter, Motormouth, Dingaling and Overdue.
