An urban location for this week's run: The Year of the Tiger run. Hare **Haggis** had already set up stall for the bright orange Tigger T shirt and was hustling for business. Meanwhile, hare **Hopeless** stumbled out of the undergrowth, bag of flour in hand.

At 4pm sharp the On was pronounced to be along Queens Road East and 1<sup>st</sup> on the left. The pack departed led by **CPH**, **Emmaroids**, **Bwaer Wabbit**, **BraveFart** and **Smallbone**. The path up needed a good head for heights and a firm grip on anything stable, especially when **DTS** lost his footing and threatened to dislodge everyone behind like dominoes with **Ice Dancer**, **Boilers** and **BOF** first in line. The trail continued along Kennedy Road and up alongside the HK Electric headquarters to Bowen Road. A split took the Wimps to the left and the Rambos to the right. The latter was marked check back and so it was on up the steps at the back. **FFFM** led the way from **Boilers**, **Yummy Mummy** and **Big P**.

At the top, the trail looped eastwards towards Wanchai Gap and from there down. Back on Bowen Road the trail headed out towards Happy Valley. At this point there was a flurry of Chinese from **Happy Valley**, **Tail of 2 Titties** and Burberry hatted friend (later to be named **3 Gorges**) asking if any chalk had been seen along the road. It was confirmed yes. Bowen Road led down into Shui Fai Terrace and along to the cemetery where the usual trail was blocked with a Tee.

So it was up the hill and over the wall and down the riverbed where there was no choice but to get wet shoes. A scramble up to the cemetery path took us on another loop, under the little foot-bridge and back along another streambed. This came out only about 50 metres from where we had started and then the next check has the FRB's checking like headless chickens, knowing the only way out was at the bottom of the cemetery.

**Inflatodate** was found totally stymied at this point and it took the combined wisdom of **CPH**, **Indy Anus** and **Bwaer Wabbit** to find the trail back up again which exited at a locked cemetery gate. This 2-metre high barrier confounded **Bwaer Wabbit**, stuck on the top like some bronze ornament, whilst the others headed up

the cliff opposite over another restricted gate for more barrier hurdling, then down the path and back towards the start.

A good trail, familiar and short-cuttable to many, and of good length. 8-10 kilometres.
